Cover Page Requirements

Please include the following information on the first page of your application:

- Full legal name
- Mailing address, telephone number, and email address
- Disclosure of any current grants or scholarships, including type and amount
- Declared major course of study
- Overall grade point average (GPA)
- College, university, or trade school currently attended or planned for enrollment

Required Attachments

- Official or unofficial transcripts for high school and any undergraduate coursework completed.
- A one-page personal statement describing your proposed course of study, long-term educational and career goals, financial need, and the specific skills and values you possess that will assist you in achieving these goals.
- A current résumé detailing past and present employment, civic and service involvement, leadership roles, extracurricular activities, and volunteer service. Please describe your most significant accomplishment and explain a meaningful obstacle or challenge you have overcome.

Letter of Reference

One (1) letter of reference must be submitted directly to the Six Rivers Masonic Lodge Scholarship Committee no later than April 15, 2025. This letter should not be included with the application materials submitted by the applicant.
